Premier's Reading Challenge

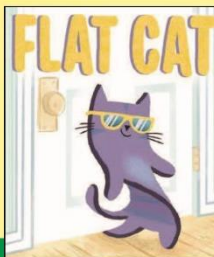
Premiers Reading Challenge is now finished. For those who have completed the challenge you will receive certificates in Term 4.

The library is now open during 2nd break EVERY day!

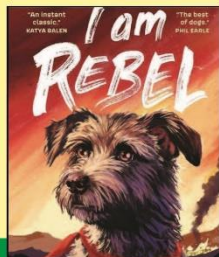
Book Fair a huge success
